What is PrEP & How do I get it?

PrEP 101

» PrEP, or pre-exposure prophylaxis, is a daily pill that can **reduce your risk** of getting HIV from sex **by more than 90%**.

» It **reduces the risk** of getting HIV from sharing needles by **more than 70%**.

» Lower your risk of getting HIV from sex even more if you take PrEP and **use other prevention methods**.

» You have to visit your doctor **every three months** to repeat your HIV test, refill your prescription, and follow-up.

» Don't take PrEP unless it has been **prescribed for you by your doctor**.
