The C.W. Williams Community Health Center, Inc. Celebrates National Health Center Week 2023 with Back-to-School Community Health Fair

CHARLOTTE, NC, August 10, 2023 –The C.W. Williams Community Health Center, Inc. (CWWCHC) hosted its 9th annual Back to School Community Health Fair on Saturday, August 5th to mark the beginning of National Health Center Week 2023 (Aug. 6 to 12). Held at the Stratford Richardson YMCA, the event was part of a national campaign to increase awareness of the many ways in which community health centers across the country provide affordable healthcare to more than 30 million patients annually. The campaign also serves to highlight the commitment and passion of Community Health Center staff, board members, and supporters. A host of events that celebrate health centers as being "Roadmaps to a Stronger America" are being held throughout the week nationwide, including health fairs, visits by elected officials to health centers, resource fairs, back to school events, patient and staff appreciation events, free health screenings, and much more.

Close to 2,000 people attended CWWCHC's health fair, which provided back to school physicals, COVID-19 vaccinations, free health screenings, free bookbags and school supplies, free eye exams with free eyeglasses, free food, live music, games, prizes, bouncy houses, an African Drum Circle, face painting, caricature and portrait sketching, and fun for the entire family. More than 65 vendors were on hand to share educational information and offer free giveaways. Special guests included North Carolina House of Representatives members Nasif Majeed (District 99), Becky Carney (District 102), and Terry Brown (District 92); North Carolina State Senator Mujtaba Mohammed (District 38); Mecklenburg County Commissioner Vilma Leake (District 2); Charlotte City Council At-Large member LaWana Mayfield; Mecklenburg Soil & Water Conservation District Supervisor Richard (Rich) George; and Mecklenburg County Register of Deeds Fredrick Smith. Presenting sponsors for this year's event included Humana, Barringer Construction Company, Village HeartBEAT, Carolinas CARE Partnership, and Walmart.

CWWCHC is part of a nationwide network of community health centers on the front lines of national public health challenges working to reduce health disparities. The organization addresses not only physical and behavioral health needs, but also the root causes of many health issues (called social determinants of health), including access to food, affordable housing, transportation and other factors that affect health and wellness.
